

**WTJU Community Advisory Board
Meeting Notes – June 14, 2017**

Primary discussion centered around Jan 2017 General Manager's report. Discussion covered the following items:

- WTJU's new mobile studio that's under construction – a converted 15-foot pull-behind camper. CAB members suggested ways this might be deployed for community impact & service
- WTJU's brand new local podcast network Teej.fm. CAB members suggested potential collaborators and audio producers who might be good to connect with
- Summer concert series. CAB members asked questions about and offered suggestions for the fall 2017 concert series planned for the IX Art Park for its third year, despite not receiving Levitt funding for this third year of event programming.
- CAB members asked about WTJU's upcoming symposium: "College Radio: Then, Now, and Next"
- CAB members also expressed concern about the White House proposed budget that eliminates funding for the Corporation for Public Broadcasting. The CPB accounts for about 14% of WTJU's total revenue
