

### **WTJU Community Advisory Board – Nov 23, 2015 minutes**

The Board discussed a number of topics informally regarding the direction of the station, including:

- Several topics discussed from the General Manager's October 2015 quarterly report (available for review at <http://www.wtju.net/wp-content/uploads/2008/09/WTJU-GM-quarterly-report-2015-Oct.pdf>).
- New reporting lines for WTJU. This month, with the retirement of Julian Bivins, WTJU moved from University Advancement to the Vice Provost for the Arts, now reporting directly to Jody Keilbasa. WTJU is now in the same division as other public-facing arts units at UVA (e.g. Fralin and Kluge-Ruhe museums, the film festival, Heritage Theater, etc.)
- Program grid changes on the way. Not really big ones, but a few: we'll be dissolving Soundboard as a stand-alone one-hour show, but injecting its content in interstitial format throughout the schedule. Jazz/blues will take over 9-10am weekdays, and evening jazz/blues will reduce to two hours per night. Evening classical will move from 6-8pm to 7-9pm Mon-Thurs. And Mon-Thurs folk shows will expand to 7pm. By and large, this has not been a controversial grid proposal among station stakeholders, but we heard feedback from CAB members.
- Recruitment for new CAB members. General discussion of individuals we might recruit and also to do an open call through on-air spots and email blasts.
